

## **West Midlands OBC – Sli.do and paper feedback analysis.**

### **1. Were you given ample notice and/or details on the “Ofsted Big Conversation?”**

82 or 100% felt they had ample notice and details about the event.

### **2. Do you feel the content was relevant to you?**

79 respondents felt the content was relevant to them. 3 respondents felt the presentation with information about the ‘Bright Beginnings’ report wasn’t relevant to them.

- **How good was the venue in terms of the following?**

### **3. Comfort and suitability.**

The vast majority of respondents were pleased with the venue and its suitability. A small proportion of delegates felt that they room was too small. The event was very well attended which is great news for us planning in the future and estimating take up of places for events.

### **4. Location and accessibility.**

100% of respondents were happy with the location of the venue and felt it was accessible.

### **5. What was your knowledge level on matters discussed before the Ofsted Big Conversation?**

Most of the delegates felt they had a middle of the road knowledge level before the event.

### **6. Has today improved your knowledge?**

76 delegates felt their knowledge level had improved after the event. Some stating that their knowledge was improved after the HR presentation and the SEF information.

6 delegates didn’t feel that their knowledge level had improved but 4 of these acknowledged that it was good to affirm their practice.

### **7. Was the day of the week and timings convenient for you?**

The timings and day of the week suited 81 of the respondents.

### **8. Would you be interested in having a whole day conference / conversation with longer presentations and more speakers?**

14 delegates would not like a longer conference.

68 felt it would be extremely worthwhile having a longer OBC with suggestions of topics like, Safeguarding, preparing for inspection, Physical development, Managing behaviour and Observational techniques. Delegates would have liked more time for the Q and A sessions at the end.

**9. Do you think today was good value for money, would you be willing to pay a higher ticket price to have more guest speakers? If yes how much would you be willing to pay?**

76 delegates were happy with the price and felt the event was good value for money. 6 attendees felt the event wasn't good value.

Respondents would be happy to pay a little more with amounts from £15 to £30 for a full day.
